SUPPORT GUIDE

Have you experienced undesirable behaviour?

If you experience or have experienced undesirable behavior you can contact one of the **confidential advisors**. They can also help you submit a claim to the Complaints Committee.

Do you want to submit a complaint regarding undesirable behaviour?

If you want to submit a formal complaint about the conduct of a Codarts staff member, you can turn to the **complaints committee**. The procedure is laid down in the regulation for complaints.

Can I contact my study coach if I experienced undesirable behaviour?

The **study coach** is the first person to go to for anything related to your study and study progress. They can help you get in contact with the confidential advisors.



Are psychological or mental issues affecting your studies?

If you are experiencing psychological problems as a result of a socially unsafe situation, the **student psychologist** provide the possibility to talk about this in an initial exploratory talk.

Are the circumstances affecting your ability to study, or do you have a disability or chronic illness?

The **student counsellor** represents the interests of students within Codarts and is the intermediary for students with a disability or chronic illness. If you have questions or problems that involve regulations and legal stipulations, the student counsellor is the person to go to.
