Can you even try to remember someone you never knew? Or reconcile with a story that is full of blanks? What if the dead in our lives can be led to a new way of being your attempt to remember the unknowable and assemble the 'could-have-been'. In an interplay of puppetry and dance, a poetic journey reveals a search for the presence of the dead in the lives of the living.

‘Spherical Body’

The Spherical Body dissects movement complexity through different stages; starting from a software algorithm based on Dominguez Rincon's method "The Spherical System" in which the audience will get information about the basic structure and origins of the choreography by interacting and organizing simple movements and creating short sequences with the avatar dancers on the screen. To continue with a live performance where real performers will develop this information to accumulate and variate into intricacy.
