Aim of the foundation

The main aim of the foundation is support in the broadest sense of the word for:
- the dance department at Codarts Rotterdam
- students in the professional dance study programmes at Codarts Rotterdam

This aim is accomplished by granting financial contributions to dance students of Codarts Rotterdam for carrying out extra study or research, taking part in internships, seminars, study programmes and courses both at home and abroad.

In addition: providing study material etc. and collaborating with persons, organizations and institutes bodies which strive for related goals.

Policy and activity plan

Each year the foundation awards scholarships to particularly talented dance students of Codarts Rotterdam. This takes place after the board of the foundation consults the dance management team of Codarts.

After students have obtained their propaedeutic certificate, they can apply with the Dansfonds Corrie Hartong for a financial contribution. This contribution is always a complement to other funding.

To apply for a scholarship, the student needs to fill in an application form. The application period runs from January 1st to April 1st in the current study year. In May of the same year, the board decides about the scholarships to be awarded. An agreement between the foundation and the student specifies that the scholarship should be used for the goal given in the application. The scholarships are presented at a public occasion, for example at the opening of the academic year or at a public performance or presentation of Codarts. Afterwards the student provides the board with a written report of how the scholarship was used.

Remuneration policy

None of the board members of the foundation receive any remuneration for his or her activities. Up to now no recompense has been given or requested for any expenses incurred, either.

Financial accountability

The foundation is classified as an ANBI, i.e. a charitable institution. This means that donors can deduct gifts from their income tax or corporate tax, with due observance of the applicable rules. Donations are very welcome on account NL85 INGB 0000 313061 in the name of Stichting Dansfonds Corrie Hartong. The gifts are fully used for supporting students.

The foundation obtains resources from sponsors, subsidies, donations, gifts, testaments and bequests. Additionally: all profits, including the profit balance from events organized for fundraising.
